

Early Years Learning at Moama Anglican Grammar

3 Year Old Preschool 2 day program

Our 3 Year Old Preschool program will offer children opportunities to learn through play, intentional learning experiences, and meaningful interactions. Inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach, children are seen as capable and curious learners, with learning environments thoughtfully designed to reflect their interests and needs.

Guided by the Early Years Learning Framework V2.0 (EYLF), our educators will create engaging experiences that support inquiry, creativity, and collaboration. The program will respond to each child's individual development, building on their strengths and gently challenging their skills.

We will provide a nurturing and inclusive environment that supports children to become confident, capable learners which builds a strong foundation for future learning.

4 Year Old Preschool 2 day program or 4 day program

Our 4 Year Old Preschool program is for children preparing to begin Kindergarten (school) the following year. It will support a smooth transition from Preschool, with a strong focus on building social and emotional wellbeing alongside key early literacy and numeracy skills.

Inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach, the program will encourage inquiry, play, and exploration, recognising children as capable and active learners. Educators will work alongside children as co-learners, observing, listening, and responding to their interests, and collaborating with them to co-construct meaningful learning experiences.

Guided by the Early Years Learning Framework V2.0 (EYLF), and supported by small class sizes, a purpose-designed environment, and access to specialist facilities, children will also participate in regular specialist classes with Primary School teachers. This will support their growth in confidence, develop a strong sense of belonging, and build readiness for Primary School.

Kindergarten (school) 5 day program

Kindergarten marks the beginning of each child's formal learning journey in our Primary School, where strong foundations are built in a calm, structured, and nurturing environment. Our Preschool programs are designed to support a smooth and confident transition into Primary School, fostering curiosity, independence and a love of learning from the very start.

Guided by dedicated and highly skilled teachers, students engage in purposeful, hands-on learning experiences that develop essential literacy and numeracy skills while encouraging creativity, inquiry, and connection to the world around them. With a strong focus on wellbeing, we prioritise each child's social and emotional growth, helping them build confidence, resilience and a strong sense of belonging.

Through a rich and diverse curriculum, access to specialist programs, and engaging learning spaces, Kindergarten students at Moama Anglican Grammar are supported to explore their interests, discover their strengths, and begin their foundational years with confidence and enthusiasm.
